

INSTALLATION

1. Park vehicle on a hard, level surface. Engage emergency brake. Place chocks in front and behind rear wheels to prevent rolling. Observe all safety precautions and wear safety glasses.

2. Starting on the driver side, raise the front of vehicle allowing the axle to hang freely. Support the frame using safety jack stands.

3. Remove the factory bump stops by pulling/twisting out of the steel mounting cup. If needed, a large flat blade screwdriver can be used to pry them out.

4. Align SumoSprings [ITEM A] into the socket and place a ³/₄" to 1" thick board between contact area and the SumoSpring. Lower the jack allowing the weight of the vehicle to drive the SumoSpring into the socket. Jack vehicle up again and remove the board.

- 5. Repeat steps 3 through 4 on the passenger side of the vehicle.
- 6. Jack up vehicle, remove safety jack stands.

7. Carefully lower vehicle. Remove the chocks in front and back of the rear wheels.

8. Register the warranty for your SuperSprings International part. A warranty card can be found in the box your part came in.
