

INSTALLATION

- **1.** Park vehicle on hard, level surface. Place wheel chocks in front and behind the front wheels to prevent rolling. Observe all safety precautions and wear safety glasses.
- **2.** Raise the rear of the vehicle allowing the axle to hang free and rest the frame on the safety jack stands rated for the weight of the vehicle. Removal of the rear wheels is optional.
- **3.** Starting on the driver side, un-bolt and remove the factory bump stop from the underside of the frame and set aside.
- 4. Place two of the Spacers [ITEM B] onto the threaded stud of the SumoSpring [ITEM A]
- **5.** Insert the threaded stud into the hole in the frame from which the factory bump stop was removed.
- 6. Secure the SumoSpring using the Flat Washer [ITEM C] and M8 Nylock Nut [ITEM D].
- 7. Repeat steps 3 through 6 on the passenger side of the vehicle.
- **8.** If rear wheels were removed you can now reinstall the rear wheels and torque wheel nuts to manufacturers specifications.
- **9.** Jack up vehicle, remove safety jack stands.
- 10. Remove wheel chocks from the front wheels.
- **11.** Register the warranty for your SuperSprings International part. A warranty card can be found in the box your part came in.
