

INSTALLATION

1. Park vehicle on level hard surface. Engage emergency brake. Place chocks in front and behind front wheels to prevent rolling. Observe all safety precautions and wear safety glasses.

2. Raise rear of vehicle allowing the axle to hang freely. Support the frame using safety jack stands.

3. Attach Upper Bracket [ITEM B] to the top of the SumoSpring [ITEM A] using two 3/8-16 x ³/₄" Serrated Flange Bolts [ITEM E]. Attach the Lower Bracket [ITEM C] to the bottom of the SumoSpring using one 3/8-16 x ³/₄" Serrated Flange Bolt [ITEM E] as in Diagram A.

4. Insert two 3/8-16 x 4" Carriage Bolts [ITEM G] into the two square openings in the Lower Bracket [ITEM C] in such a way that they straddle the factory spring-pack. Position the Lower Bracket so that the curved side finger captures the factory u-bolt.

5. Secure the Lower Bracket [ITEM C] to the factory spring-pack using the U-Bracket Strap [ITEM D] the two 3/8-16 x 4" Carriage Bolts [ITEM G], and two 3/8-16 Top-lock Flange Nuts [ITEM H].

6. Repeat steps 3 through 5 on the opposite side of the vehicle.

7. Jack up axle until Upper Bracket [ITEM B] is in correct position on frame with the two bottom holes aligned with the existing 5/8" holes in the frame as shown in Diagram B below. Mark and drill two upper holes using a 7/16" drill bit (ensure clearance on all cables/service lines inside the frame prior to drilling).

8. Repeat step 7 on opposite side.

9. Carefully lower vehicle to the hard surface. Remove the chocks in front and back of the rear wheels.

10. Register the warranty for your SuperSprings International part. A warranty card can be found in the box your part came in.
